

Hybrid Dual Decoration System for the Epson 4880

The Epson 4880 is a direct replacement for the previous Epson 4800 printer. This printer is designed for customers who are interested in a high yield, high efficiency and high speed sublimation system. The Epson 4880 allows the end-user to print letter size documents to full bleed 17" x 50 foot banners.

Q. How is the Epson 4880 Hybrid dual decoration system different from the previous Epson 4800 Hybrid dual decoration system solution?

A. Sawgrass Technologies has developed a color management system for the Epson 4880 that closely match the same color output obtained on the Epson 4800.

Q. Will I be able to use SubliJet or ChromaBlast 4800 ink cartridges in the Epson 4880 printer?

A. No. There are some subtle changes between the two printer cartridges that will not allow the Epson 4800 cartridges to work in the 4880 printer.

Q. What type of computer system will I need to get the optimum output?

A. A Pentium 4 3.0 GHz or higher processor is recommended.
1 GB RAM is the minimum recommended memory. 2 GB RAM is highly recommended to process larger documents with high quality settings.
30 GB RAM of free hard driver space is required for proper software and file management.

Q. What is the major advantage of the Epson 4880 Hybrid Dual Decoration system?

A. The dual CMYK functionality of the Epson 4880 Hybrid system enables the ultimate in flexibility and production in a digital printing environment. The Hybrid system allows for printing both sublimation and cotton transfers using either SubliJet or ChromaBlast inks.

Q. What paper sizes does the Epson 4880 support?

A. The Epson 4880 can print from letter size (8.5 x 11) to continuous rolls of 17" x 50 feet.

Q. Who should use the Epson 4880 Hybrid Dual Decoration system?

A. The 4880 Hybrid system should only be sold to customers that will be printing similar proportions of SubliJet and ChromaBlast inks. For customers that will not use the two ink systems in nearly equal amounts, Sawgrass advises the use of two separate systems, one for decorating cotton (ChromaBlast) such as the C120, Epson 1800 or Epson 4880 and one for sublimation decoration (SubliJet) such as the C120, Epson 1400, Epson 1800 or Epson 4880.

- Q. What is the ink configuration of Epson 4880 Hybrid Dual Decoration system?**
- A. The ink configuration is a Dual CMYK, the same as the Epson 4800 hybrid system.
